

## **RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. The committee will adhere as closely as possible to the published schedule and programme but reserve the right in their absolute discretion to put forward or alter any class through lack of entries, or any other reason.
2. No claim can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or animals in connection with or arising out of this show. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from any accident.
3. All owners and riders (and where applicable their parents/guardians) or horses/ponies competing in any competition shall be deemed to be subject to the rules and regulations of the BRITISH SHOWJUMPING as though each of them were members of the associations.
4. Conduct and disciplinary powers as per BRITISH SHOWJUMPING rules will be strictly adhered to.
5. The committee reserves the right to change any judge shown in this schedule at their discretion.
6. The decision of the judges, in all cases, is final.
7. Horses and ponies, when not competing must be kept in the collecting rings or exercise areas.
8. No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to complete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
9. Objections must be to the Secretary's tent in writing within 15 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a deposit of £50, returnable at the judges discretion.
10. Cup winners are requested to ensure that their trophies are collected from the Treasurer after ring presentation. It is also the cup winners responsibility to insure cups and trophies whilst in their possession during the following year and to return challenge trophies to the Entries Secretary by 1<sup>st</sup> July the following year.
11. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry.

If a competitor withdraws from the second round he/she will not be replaced and he/she will receive placing from the first round. At least five prizes have to be awarded.*
